A. Check List of Things to Do **Before PAINT DAY**

1. Fill out the **Homeowner's Contact Sheet** (given to you at the time you select a house). Please put your information on it and give it to the homeowner when you meet to discuss your plans.
2. Take the **Painters' Waiver** with you to the house on paint day and have all painters sign it, and a Bucket Brigade committee member will pick it up from you.
3. At this time, walk around outside of house and make a list of what needs to be done.
4. Make a list of tools needed (Painters must furnish)
 - Inspect house & make sure electrical is covered
 - Paint Brushes
 - Scrapers
 - Wire Brushes
 - Ladders, extension and step
 - Hammers
 - Screw Drivers - other hand tools
 - Large Garbage Bags (for litter)
 - Putty Knife
 - Drop Cloth
 - Rags and Paper Towels
 - Old Newspaper
 - Other specific items of your choosing
5. Get paint from Sherwin Williams. Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday before paint day.
6. Contact Workers. Give them information on what to bring and the house address.

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B. **PAINT DAY - MAY 9, 2020**

1. As workers arrive at the house, have workers sign the waiver form with their name and address.

2.  Pizzas and beverages will be delivered to your work site between 11:30 & 12:30 as a thank you for your volunteer efforts. Your Bucket Brigade Committee Contact will get the head count that morning.
